JOB SUMMARY:

This role is key to delivering the Bremerton Sports Center's mission of promoting player development, enjoyment of the game, and athletic excellence.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Basic knowledge of individual player development with a focus on both tactical and technical aspects of soccer
- Familiarity with local club, recreational, and school soccer programs in the Bremerton area
- Coaching certification (e.g., USSF D License or equivalent) preferred
- 1-2 years of coaching or training experience (soccer-related or otherwise)
- Ability to work flexible hours, including evenings and weekends, to accommodate training schedules
